

When I purchased this edition, I thought I was receiving the 2012 version. Instead I received the 2005 version, and even that is pretty outdated. If you really want to know how to file a legal malpractice case, there are some good terms but overall, it really doesn't help someone who is pro se, like myself. It doesn't really go into detail as to the "facts" that are the cause of action, or the "but for". It just covers it generally, like all the free documents on the internet do. So it is a nice read, but if you are desperately searching for knowledge, like I am, this is not the book for you.

This book is a good primer on the subject. It will point you in the right direction to begin or stop the

process before going too far. But as with any book on legal topics, so much is state-specific, a general volume can only take you so far. Therefore, as much as a little book like this can do, it does, and it does it pretty well.
