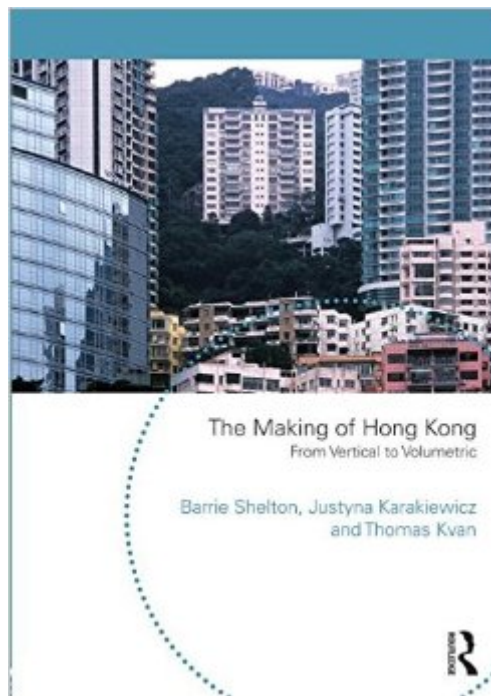


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The Making Of Hong Kong: From Vertical To Volumetric (Planning, History And Environment (Paperback))
