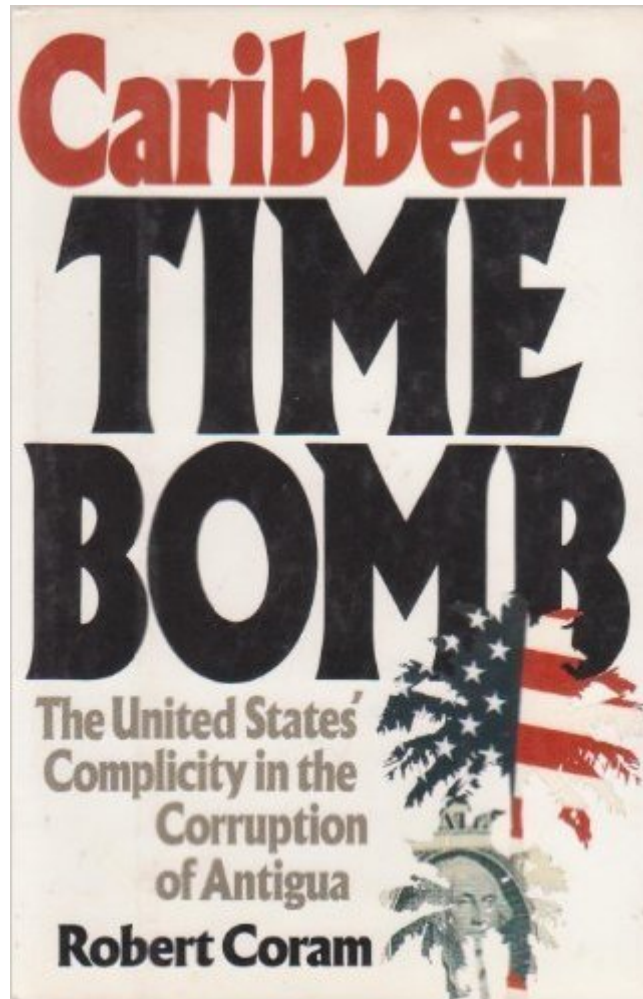


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Caribbean Time Bomb: The United States' Complicity In The Corruption Of Antigua
