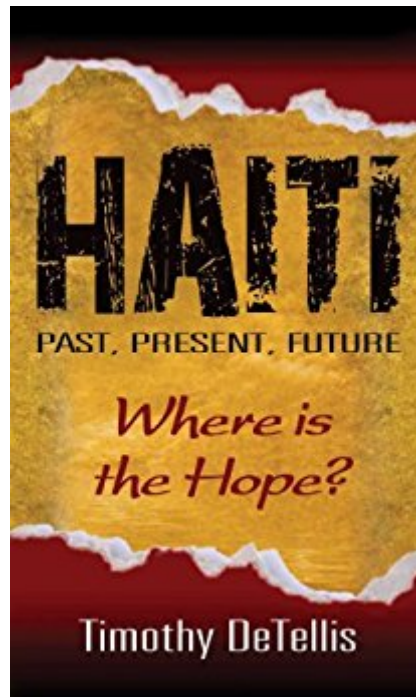

Tim DeTellis, writing from a Christian perspective, does a good job of summarizing the main

movements in the history of Haiti. He brings the reader up to the end of 2009. Since then Haiti experienced an epic earthquake that changed everything. The new president of Haiti (Martelly) has prioritized some of the things DeTellis mentions in this book: education, infrastructure, etc. The author promotes New Missions in the last chapter, a work started by his parents which has grown and has been very effective.

The writer is clearly not a historian... why was this book published? A couple examples:-He says that the United States occupied Haiti in 1916 to counter the growing influence of NAZI GERMANY. Nazi Germany... in 1916???-He refers to non-Christians as devil-worshippers, pagans, and sinners, and tries to convince readers that Haiti troubles are God's punishment for voodooism. This type of commentary is absolutely unacceptable in a book that claims to be historical, and makes the ancient Greek and Roman historians of the BC years look objective and scientific in comparison.

I was part of MINUSTAH (UN mission) living three years in Haiti and I have to say that the book is fantastic and describes the Haiti past, destiny and hope exactly as Haitians and those who love Haiti like me feel in our heart. I recommend this book specially the solutions that the author considers as part of the hope for a new Haiti.
